

#### Meeting commences 19:36

- 1. Receive any apologies for absence as above.
- 2. Agree minutes of last AGM Agreed
- 3. President's Report IC Thanks to people showing an interest to the club and attending tonight's meeting. The annual Presidents Day will be this September the 8<sup>th</sup>, please all come along and support to raise money for charity. IC found some interesting club heritage that if you weren't attending the AGM in 1928, you had to send a hand written letter to the President!
- 4. Secretaries Reports ME: Lots of weather related issues in the second half of the season, but we all managed to get through it without too much damage being done. GDPR has taken a lot of time over the last few months, keep an eye out for updates. EH affiliation fees are due to increase by 1.5% for 18/19 season. NTH: GDPR, comes into force next Friday the 25<sup>th</sup>, as we hold information that identifies who you are we have to comply. We hold your name and email, you need to update your settings on MailChimp, please do that; email is going out again next week. What will be classed as sensitive data, which is basically your Player Registration information, gets deleted at the end of every season and you will need to opt in every year. New policy page on the website, committee will be fully updated. If there is a breach of information, up to £20million pound fine if we get it wrong. SW asked can we just send an email that auto enrols? No, GDPR states you need to opt in. AC Captains with mobile numbers etc? Answer, keep the data secured on a locked pass coded device.
- 5. Adult captains' reports
  - a. Ladies 3<sup>rd</sup> XI report Clare Kane: with the disappointment of last season behind us, we started the season with a 10-0 win. Mixture of results followed but finished mid top half of table. We didn't have a full-time keeper so thanks to those who stepped in. Post Christmas Vix came back after a year out due to injury, had 4 wins on the bonce and were jostling at the top of the table. Finished third in the league. Lots of great young talent coming through, push for promotion next year. Top goal scorer Alex, 31 goals. Player Of The Season Lucy Saunders.
  - b. Men's 2<sup>nd</sup> XI report Chris Gay: difficult season after only two teams playing in the league this year, we finished rock bottom with a goal difference of over minus 100. Though if the season was awarded on effort we'd have finished top. CG is standing down. Player Of The Season was Robin Durham who played in every position this year.

- c. Ladies 2<sup>nd</sup> XI report Ruth Belcher: won first friendly 6-0 in December, although perhaps a little unexpected. Finished the season with a 13-0 nil win. 1D and 2L meant we won the league with a goal difference of +54 and were 3 points clear, won promotion to North. Thanks to everyone especially the coaches. Player Of The Season Jess Brain. Trophy awarded by Face Time during the AGM.
- d. Men's 1<sup>st</sup> XI report no report submitted 1<sup>st</sup> team captain. Adrian Chambers: There was only 4 points different between 4<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> in the league, so that shows how tight it was and did well to finish 8<sup>th</sup>.
- e. Ladies 1<sup>st</sup> XI report Zoe Vale (not present): Mixed results buy played some great hockey. Started brightly but only picked up 9 points in the first half of the season. A trip to Plymouth saw a striker playing in goal, sleet snow and timing mix up, but still won 2-1, a big boost for the squad. All came down to the last game (rearranged vs Taunton), a 0-0 draw saw our security in Prem1 next season. Top goal scorer Zoe Vale with 4. Player Of The Season
- 6. Junior section report Lucy Joy: Junior section has grown massively, Darren doing the U8/U10 and the results have been great. Summer camps going and the attendance is great. Some U14s have been playing in the senior team, and been doing really well. Boys U14 reached the semi-finals, girls U14 won the U14 plate for the Avon League, had 11 YOs playing in that squad too! Lucie Goulding playing in the senior team. No U16s this year. Darren Ashley: if anyone else can spare time to help that would be great. Thanks to Matt and Dom for taking the badgers, umpires Andy Newell and Clare Kane, Isabella organising the U14, everyone who's helped doing the coaching, Jo, Darren Shauna. Quite a lot of players nominated for county and Performance Centres. (ZV report below)
- 7. Finance Secretaries' Reports (Reports attached below)
  - a. Ladies Penny Kawecki: some movements still left to be made, there are still some monies outstanding due to YOSC for pitch hire, discussion currently ongoing with YOSC over 17/18 pitch hire charges. Meeting on the 25<sup>th</sup> of May to try and resolve. Current outlook shows a £317 profit made this year. Fundraising has made a big impact. Still a lot of outstanding match fees to collect though. Payment plans made to be need clearer. PK to email current captain on final match fees outstanding.
  - b. Juniors Penny Kawecki: juniors made a £638 loss this year, still have cash in the bank though. Last year's summer training money went into last year's accounts. Player charges are the same, though pitch hire has increased because of the higher number of juniors. Affiliation fees have almost doubled due to the number of teams entered.
  - c. Member's Club Penny Kawecki: The club fundraising fund saw a contribution to YOSCs new dugouts this year, but still overall looking fine.
  - d. Men's Adrian Chambers: AC said that a lot of this year's success is all down to the support of the club through socials. Men made a £700 profit, mid-year looked shakey but we were able to help reduce any loses by reducing training pitch hire time to lack of numbers attending training. Thanks to all club umpires for their help this year as we didn't have county appointed umpires this year.
  - e. Annual fees Mike Edwards: currently no expectation to increase annual fees and match fees. Carolyn Rolleston raised about looking for longer term fundraising to help sustain the club. ME to propose to YOSC that paid work would be put toward 'credit account' for the club towards pitch hire fees.
- 8. Other updates from the Committee
  - a. Communications: Sarah Wells: please do send match reports though they need to go to one person to collate and distribute to the papers. If the teams are struggling to find someone to do them, do a 'moment of the match' at the same time as the MOM votes to help come up with the ideas.



- b. Social: Lucy Saunders: had a lot of younger players and families along which was great. Good bingo social and annual dinner was well received. We'll try to get dates out for 18/19 season asap.
- c. Clubmark: Vicky Haigh not present. Mike Edwards: This is the new Clubs First EH accreditation, this is all but there and aiming to have all signed off shortly.
- d. CASC Community Amateur Sports Club Penny Kawecki: CASB will enable us to get donations as we will be registered as CASC with HMRC. Constitution updated to reflect this, primary reason is to receive donations from large businesses (i.e. KPMG) who look for the club to be a CASC.
- e. YOSC update Mike Edwards: Brief overview of current YOSC FM and Lodge Sports position, Andy Lathall is the new facilities manager and contact should go to him. There will still be the expectation to have the cleaning rota for out changing rooms (5-8). Employment and volunteering opportunities available at YOSC behind the bar. Pitch condition and fotballers wearing blades is still a concern, we must continue to police and ask for YOSC support when needed. Someone raised about the early ladies time slots changing for BAPS? Requires investigation.
- f. Fundraising Nikki ter Haar: Tesco Bags of Help was entered this year, we were awarded £2000. This will be used for keeper kits and training equipment, Darren has volunteered to check the GK kit in the container. We can re-apply and the top money could get up to £4,000. If anyone has got any fundraising opportunities, please contact Nikki. PK: Additional £1500 in from Easyfundraising.
- g. O35's update Zoe Vale (not present): Lost first game in Tier 2 but won 3-0 against Andover in Tier 3. Snow postponed the next fixture which was decided on a coin toss! Through to the Semi-finals in Teddington, unfortunately lost 2-3. Thaks to all those that travelled, played and umpired.
